Guests Living Outside Martin County

Your guests from outside Martin County are welcome 5 times per year to use the club facilities with you and attend all club functions. There is no pool fee for guests from outside of Martin County, however we do ask that you register all guests with the lifeguard.

Guests Living in Martin County

Any resident of Martin County may be a guest 2 times per year. The in-county guest charge is \$5/person or \$15/family. Guests must register upon entering the pool area.

Nanny/Childcare

Primary caregivers (nannies) are only allowed to be at the club when the parents are unable to be present. The Nanny does **not** have any membership rights outside of taking care of the children. They do **not** have use of the club solely on their own. Persons assisting parents in care must pay the visitor fee for the day. Primary caregivers for children under 8 years old must be 18 years or older.

Work Hours Program

The Work Hours Program is designed to encourage members to become more involved in the Yacht Club. The Yacht Club has included an initial \$100.00 work assessment fee with a majority of the membership programs. If a member performs certain tasks at the club, each hour worked will decrease the following year's work assessment fee. Each hour that a membership works will earn them \$10.00 off the assessment.

RULES:

- Each membership can elect to complete \$100.00 of “work dollars”. Any family member included in the membership can earn the hours.
- Only completed tasks can earn the hours. Just signing up for an activity does not count.
- You will need to complete a “work hours” form and submit it to one of the Board Members to be signed off and receive credit. Hours are logged by administration and will be posted to your membership on the website.
- Once you have completed your 10 hours, any extra help is appreciated but will not earn you any hours towards your membership or next year's hours.
- Work hours can be amassed from January 1 - December 31.

Clubhouse Rentals

The Yacht Club facilities may be rented by members and non-members for meetings, parties or special functions. Rentals can use the pool as long as there is adult supervision. All rentals require a **\$200.00 deposit** which will be returned after inspection of the clubhouse with no damage and return of the clubhouse key.

The Clubhouse will be unlocked from 8:00 am - 5:30 pm unless there is a private rental or club event. The Clubhouse will be locked the day before a private rental to allow for paid cleaning services and rentees preparing for their event.

Pool Hours and Rules

The pool is open to members 24 hours a day (for ages 18 and older)
Lifeguard Hours: 12:30pm - 5:30pm daily.

- » Yacht Club adult members or supervised children are welcome to use the pool with the lifeguard is off duty.
- » The Yacht Club is not responsible for injuries incurred by individuals who swim during pool treatment.
- » The pool is closed to open swimming during swimming lessons
- » Lifeguards will not be on duty during inclement weather.
- » Adults swim at their own risk when a lifeguard is not on duty.
- » Children 8 years and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- » Unsupervised children ages 9 to 17 must sign in and list an emergency contact number.
- » Swimmers 17 years and under must have adult supervision to use the pool when a lifeguard is not on duty.
- » There is **no** lifeguard supervision of the wading pool or beach. **Parents** are responsible for the safety of their children.
- » Glass is not permitted in the pool area (MN State Law). If any glass is broken, the pool must be drained, cleaned and refilled. This process takes 5 days. Violators will be responsible to pay the fees for this process. The minimum cost is \$500.00.
- » Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
- » During the 10 minute lifeguard breaks, adults and adults with babies may enjoy exclusive use of the pool.
- » Pets are not allowed in the pool area or clubhouse.
- » Children not obeying the lifeguard or Yacht Club rules may be asked to leave the Yacht Club grounds at the discretion of the lifeguard.
- » No water balloons in the pool area.
- » No food **in** the pool.
- » Bring toys and floatation devices, but take them home with you daily.

Waterfront

- » Boat docking is offered to Yacht Club members who have a boat slip membership. If you own a boat and a lift and would like to keep it at the Yacht Club please email the following address: contactus@fairmontyachtclub.com. We also offer our members winter storage of boat lifts only (no watercraft) as well as summer trailer storage for member slip renters. Summer is defined as the time between dock-in and dock-out day.
- » Boats must be stored in designated slip overnight. Boats left on trailers are not allowed to be stored on the Yacht Club property overnight.
- » If you are a boat slip renter and are keeping your trailer at the Yacht Club during the summer, please do not leave it in the parking lot or lawn. Please park it in the designated area. The Yacht Club reserves the right to move such property in order to complete routine maintenance (i.e. lawn mowing, trimming, etc.)
- » We spend a day in spring and fall to get the docks and lifts put in and taken out of the lake. It is required that you be present or provide a substitute or you will be billed \$150.00 as a no-show fee.
- » Junior members do **not** have boat lift or trailer storage privileges.
- » Please fill in all holes dug in the beach so that no injuries occur.
- » We have a firepit on the patio and on the beach. Before leaving make sure your fire is out and the area is picked up.
- » Please do not leave boat covers, gas cans, etc. on the docks unattended.
- » If you have a boat at the Yacht Club please check it after a storm to make sure it's still safe. If vandalism occurs, please report it to the police and notify the Yacht Club immediately so we can make all members aware.
- » For safety reasons and MN Boating Regulations, you may not accelerate within 200 feet of the end of our docks.
- » Please be on the watch out for swimmers and floatation devices in and around the beach area of the Yacht Club.
- » All boat lifts and trailers must be tagged with a waterproof tag.
- » The Yacht Club is not responsible for theft, vandalism, or damage to any of the personal items left on site.
